

Prayer Points for 2018 Lenten Season



This Lenten season, the Global Missions Team at FPCSM invites you to join in prayer for a “business as mission” project among one of the largest unreached Muslim people groups in Indonesia. The Southeast Asia Mariculture Project involves building a small-scale sea cucumber hatchery to open doors to closed Muslim communities that have no witness among them.

Indonesia is comprised of more than 17,000 islands and there are thousands upon thousands of small fishing villages scattered across them. Most families in these areas subsist on minimal income from the catch of small fish. And, most of them are almost completely unengaged with the Gospel. There are no believers among them, near them or going to them. This project is designed to both take the Gospel to these Muslim communities and generate a means of sustainable revenue for them.

February 19-25 Pray:

- for open hearts among the Indonesian people
- for the project team to share boldly and with sensitivity and love

February 26-March 4 Pray:

- for continued safety and good health, as there is a lot of boat travel among the islands and significant disease risks

March 5-11 Pray:

- for relationships between expatriate and national church planters to be strengthened as they work side by side, utilizing their gifts and backgrounds in a common vision

March 12-18 Pray:

- for wisdom as the team establishes partnerships with local fishermen, that they would be led to people of integrity

March 19-25 Pray:

- for the team as it works with government officials to protect the marine resources

March 26-April 1 Pray:

- for the families of team members to make wise decisions, especially in terms of educational choices for their children
