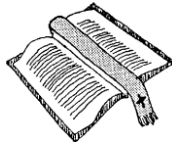

What is Kingdom Club?



Kingdom Club is a fun place for grade-school age kids (Kindergarten through 5th grade) to be on Wednesday nights! Each week, children have a great time enjoying dinner with friends (kid-friendly foods!), playing games, singing, and learning about God and how He cares for them. In addition to having an awesome time each week, participants also work throughout the session to learn songs and drama for a musical presentation that is given at the conclusion of the session.

Entering our 21st year, Kingdom Club is offered by First Presbyterian Church San Mateo as an enhancement to our Sunday morning classes, and as an enrichment program for children in our community.



How do I Register?

Participants may register for Kingdom Club by completing and returning the enclosed form to the Children's Ministry office at First Presbyterian Church. A fee of \$85.00 per session (*Fall Session runs Sept.–Dec. and the Winter/Spring Session runs Jan.–May*) is requested to cover the cost of dinners each week, the musical CD, crafts and a Kingdom Club T-shirt. Partial scholarships are available upon request.



What about singing?

A big part of Kingdom Club is singing, and each week children have a great time learning and singing songs for a musical that they present at the end of the session. Children who are interested will also have an opportunity to try-out for solos or speaking parts in the musical. In addition, all children are encouraged to participate each time the Kingdom Club choir is scheduled to sing in worship services at First Presbyterian Church (usually once per session). These presentations give children an opportunity to build their confidence and become comfortable singing and speaking in front of a crowd as they share what they have worked hard to learn!

Parent Participation
