Be a part of the 5-week all-church class, *When God's People Pray*. This DVD-based study will enhance your understanding of, and increase your devotion to, prayer!

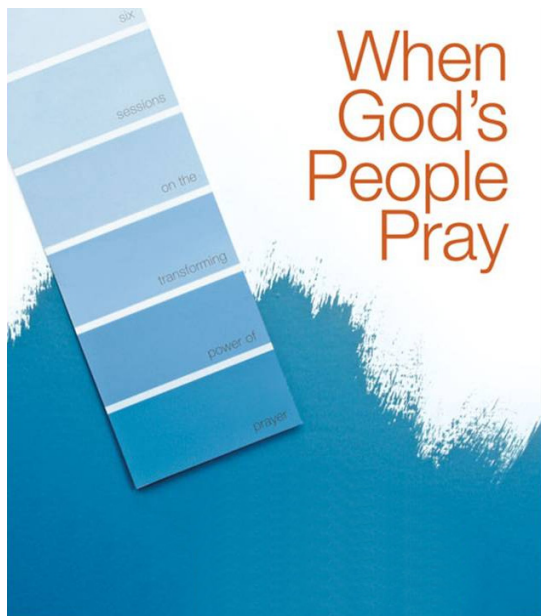
