



## Parent Information

Welcome to Kingdom Club! We're excited that your child is a part of our mid-week program! Read below for answers to many of the questions you may have about Kingdom Club. ### Health

For the protection of all the children and staff in our program, we ask that you do not bring your child to Kingdom Club if your child or anyone in your household has any of the following symptoms: fever of 100.4°F or higher, cough, chills, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea, contagious skin rash, or positive COVID-19 test.

Masks must be worn by all children, parents and staff with the exception of during the dinner service.

### Arrival

Kingdom Club begins with singing in our Sanctuary at **5:30pm - please try to have your child here on time**. Kingdom Club leaders are in the entryway of the church each week to greet children; you may drop-off your child in the loading zone in front of the church beginning at 5:15pm if you don't wish to park your car. Children should **always check-in** with the Kingdom Club leader as soon as they arrive at the church.

### Dinner

Unfortunately, we are not able to serve dinner to children arriving after 5:50pm. If your child must arrive at Kingdom Club after 5:50pm we request that you serve them dinner beforehand.

We will practice social distancing, serve dinner in our dining hall and on our outdoor patio (weather permitting) to spread out tables, and reduce the number of children at each dinner table. Only student and adult leaders will serve food to minimize touching of utensils, etc.

### Pick-up

Kingdom Club ends at 7:30pm in Geneva Hall (straight ahead as you enter the church's patio area). Parents are asked to wait on the patio. We will send the children out to the patio after closing. Thank you for not lingering on the patio after dismissal. Children will not be allowed to leave the church without a parent or guardian. Please remember that Hacienda & 25<sup>th</sup> Avenue are very busy streets and it is difficult for drivers to see children particularly after dark. Make sure your child picks up their craft and belongings to bring home with you.
